**STEP BACK IN TIME BY THE SINGAPORE RIVER
TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

Important Notice: You can only participate in this Challenge once and strongly encouraged to come in sports attire and covered shoes.

Event Date: 20 July 2019 (Saturday) and 21 July 2019 (Sunday)

Event Duration: 10am – 3pm

Venue: Hardcourt at Asian Civilisations Museum (ACM)

Nearest station: Raffles Place MRT

Registration Period: From 8 July onwards

1. Eligibility

- 1.1. You must be a Singapore or Permanent Resident of Singapore, above 17 years old with a valid NRIC or a foreigner with a valid FIN. Please bring along your valid NRIC/FIN for verification onsite.
- 1.2. Eligible Participants who are 17 years of age must obtain parental consent before participating in this Challenge.
- 1.3. You must be a registered Participant of the Step Back in Time by the Singapore River Challenge.

2. Official Challenge Period

- 2.1. Step Back in Time by the Singapore River Challenge will be held across 2 days from 20 – 21 July 2019. Participants can choose to participate on either 20 or 21 July.
- 2.2. Registration period starts from 8 July 2019.

3. Mechanics

- 3.1 Each eligible Participant will be given a game card at registration booth at the Hardcourt at Asian Civilisations Museum on 20 or 21 July 2019. Last check-in is at 2.00pm on each day.
- 3.2 Follow the instructions on the game card to find and complete the game stations around Asian Civilisations Museum and the Singapore River. Each Participant who completes each game station successfully will be given 1 unique stamp.
- 3.3 There are a total of 3 game stations around Asian Civilisations Museum and the Singapore river.
- 3.4 1 of the 3 game stations, the Time Traveler game station, will be exclusive for the Merdeka Generation and Pioneer Generation Participants. Only Participants who qualify as Merdeka Generation or Pioneer Generation will be able to participate in this game station.
- 3.5 After completing 2 game stations, Participants can join the BALIKSG Augmented Reality (AR) app game.
- 3.6 Participants with at least 2 completed game stations will receive the exclusive National Steps Challenge™ goodie bag with sure-win prizes. Participants with at least 2 completed game stations and complete the BALIKSG AR app game will qualify for our Post-Event Lucky Draw.

4. How to Participate

Participants have to:

Step 1: Download the Healthy 365 mobile app on your smartphone, create a profile and Sign up for Step Back in Time by the Singapore River Challenge on the Challenges tab via the Healthy 365 mobile app. Registration starts from 8 July 2019.

Step 2: Consent to the Terms & Conditions to complete sign up.

Step 3: Download the BALIKSG AR mobile app prior to on-site check-in

Step 4: Check-in on-site at the Hardcourt at Asian Civilisations Museum. Last check-in for each day is at 2.00pm.

Step 5: Complete the game card by participating in the game stations around Asian Civilisations Museum and the Singapore river. In addition, complete the BALIKSG AR app game to qualify for our Grand Mystery Draw.

Step 5: Upon completion of at least 2 stations, you may proceed to the prize redemption booth at the Hardcourt at Asian Civilisations Museum to redeem your goodie bag with sure-win prizes. Once verified that you have completed the BALIKSG AR app game, you will also qualify for our Grand Mystery Draw.

5. Sure-win Prizes

- 5.1. Participants need to submit their game card to the prize redemption booth in order to claim their prizes. Once the game card is verified and prizes are redeemed, the Participant will not be allowed to continue with the challenge.
- 5.2. - 5.5. HPB reserves the right to end on-site registration before the indicated timing, in the event that all game cards are fully issued and all prizes and premiums are fully redeemed on-site.

6. Grand Mystery Draw

- 6.1. To qualify for the Grand Mystery Draw, Participants must complete at least 2 game stations and successfully complete the BALIKSG AR app game. This entitles each eligible Participant to 1 lucky draw chance.
- 6.2. Participants need to submit their game card for redemption and verification at the prize redemption booth latest by 3.00pm. Once the game card is submitted, the Participant will not be allowed to continue with the Challenge.

- 6.3. The lucky draw will not be conducted on-site as it is a post-event draw. Winners will be contacted by email and/or mobile by 12 August 2019. Hence, all eligible Participants should ensure that their profile information in Healthy 365 mobile app is accurate. Prizes for uncontactable Participants will be forfeited.
- 6.4. Collection of prizes will be from Health Promotion Board. If the winner is unable to collect his/her prizes personally, he/she may authorize someone to collect on his/her behalf.
- 6.5. All lucky draws will be conducted in ascending order of prize categories (i.e. lowest value prize to highest value prize).
- 6.6. Participants are only allowed to win in 1 prize category for the lucky draw.
- 6.7. If the prize winners are under the age of 18, the prize must be claimed by their parent or legal guardian.
- 6.8. Prizes are not exchangeable for cash. Refund or exchanges in prizes is strictly not allowed.

- 7.3. HPB may use the necessary Personal Data for publicity, liaison, advertising or marketing purposes in connection with any HPB programmes/outreach/initiatives/activities.
- 7.4. Participants must be responsible for providing complete and accurate contact information to HPB and its organisers. HPB accepts no responsibility for any inability or failure to contact the Participants arising from inaccurate or incomplete contact information.

8. **Limitation of Liability**

- 8.1. All Participants of the Step Back in Time by the Singapore River Challenge agree that neither HPB nor their affiliates, employees, directors, officers, agents and/or assignees shall be liable in any way for, and shall be indemnified, released, discharged and held harmless, fully and effectively, by each Participant against and from any and all claims by any Participant or third party for:
 - a) Slander, libel, defamation, violation of rights of privacy, publicity, and/or civil rights, depiction in a false light, intentional or negligent, infliction of emotional distress, copyright infringement, and/or any other tort and damages arising from or in any other way related to their participation in the challenge.
 - b) All injuries, losses or damages to property or person of any kind, including death, claims, actions, proceedings and other liability arising out of or caused in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, by the acceptance, possession, use or misuse of the prizes or participation in the challenge.

- c) Any lost, late, mechanically duplicated, illegible, incomplete, mutilated, tampered, damaged, corrupted or misdirected game cards; and
- d) Any losses, costs, expenses, fees or damages incurred by the Participants arising out of or in connection with the challenge or any activity related thereto, including without limitation, any breakdown or malfunction of any computer system or equipment.

- 9.3 HPB reserves the right at its sole discretion, to suspend, postpone or terminate the challenge or shorten or extend the duration of challenge and/or amend, modify, delete, supplement, replace or revise the Terms & Conditions, without any liability or prior notification to any person, including but not limited to any Participant.
- 9.4 HPB shall not be liable to any party whatsoever for any delay in complying or failure to comply with the Terms & Conditions due to the occurrence of any event or circumstance beyond its control, including without any limitation to, acts of God, natural disasters or catastrophes, riots or wars (whether declared or not), terrorist activities, epidemics, health threats, quarantine requirements, change or issuance of new applicable laws.
- 9.5 HPB further reserves the right to modify and/or terminate the reward scheme of the Challenge at any time at its sole discretion without any further notice to Participants.
- 9.6 HPB may, in its sole and absolute discretion and without prior notice, replace, change or substitute any prizes with another of similar value.
- 9.7 HPB reserves the right to disqualify any entries, forfeit any prize or require return of the prize presented to the Participant if:
 - HPB, in its sole discretion, decides that the participation is not valid;
 - The Participant does not agree to abide by and be bound by the Terms & Conditions;

 - Participant(s) who failed to provide true, correct and accurate information at any point of contact;
- 9.8 HPB discovers or has reasonable grounds to suspect that the Participant has engaged or attempted to engage in any activity to inappropriately manipulate submission procedures including without limitation the unauthorised use of profiles not belonging to the Participant.
- 9.9 In all circumstances, HPB's decisions shall be final, binding and conclusive on all matters relating to challenge and lucky draw, and no further correspondence shall be entertained. Participants agree and undertake to be bound by the aforesaid decisions.
- 9.10 The Terms & Conditions shall be governed by the laws of Singapore. The Terms & Conditions shall constitute the entire understanding and agreement between the HPB and the Participants. The Terms & Conditions are not intended to confer rights on any third party cap, whether pursuant

HPB's failure to enforce at any time the provisions of the Terms & Conditions or any rights in respect thereto shall in no way be considered to be a waiver of such provisions, rights, or elections or in any way affect the validity of the Terms & Conditions.
- 9.12 In the event of any inconsistency between the Terms & Conditions and any brochure, marketing or promotional material relating to challenge, the Terms & Conditions shall prevail.
