

COMMUNITY CHALLENGE NEIGHBOURHOOD ACTIVATIONS TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Community Challenge Neighbourhood Activations are post-roadshow activations that provide a platform for National Steps Challenge[™] Season 4 (NSC 4) participants to sustain an active lifestyle and clock more steps. Each activation will include a chance for you to participate in The Greater Singapore Workout with your fellow residents, Sundays @ The Park (SATP) workout, game stations and a QR code hunt.

Mechanics & Prizes

Register at the Community Challenge Neighbourhood Activations registration booth held at the following locations (Table 1) and obtain a game card.

- To be entitled a stamp, participants have to complete a SATP workout or game station.
- Participants who have obtained at least 2 stamps on their game card will be entitled to redeem a goodie bag on the same day, within the activation hours.
- Participants who managed to find three correct QR Codes for the QR Code Hunt will be entitled to win up to 600 Healthpoints.

How to Participate?

Download the Healthy 365 mobile app on your smartphone, create a profile and sign up for the National Steps Challenge[™] Season 4. Choose a preferred tracking mode. Ensure that the camera function and location tracking are allowed so you will be able to scan the QR Codes for the QR Code Hunt. Note that internet connection is also required to scan the QR codes. Register at the National Steps Challenge[™] Community Challenge Neighbourhood Activations registration booth at the locations (Table 1) and obtain a game card. Note that you must agree to the terms and conditions of Community Challenge Neighbourhood Activation before you can participate in the event.
